successful career as a disability rights attorney, including spending three years as an attorney advisor at the US Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. His perspective is also informed by his personal experience with bipolar disorder. Mr. Imparato graduated with distinction from Stanford Law School and is a summa cum laude graduate of Yale College.
