


### **New Know Your Rights Brochure**

The Office of Congressional Workplace Rights (OCWR) has revised its Know Your Rights in the Legislative Branch brochure with updated information on the OCWR's administrative dispute resolution process under the Congressional Accountability Act (CAA).

The brochure also provides information on the work of the OCWR, who is covered by the CAA, and the workplace rights and protections afforded by the Act, along with OCWR contact information.

#### **OSH Fast Fact** Take the OCWR Safety Quiz

The CAA requires legislative branch employing offices to provide their employees with workplaces that are free from recognized hazards. Legislative branch employers and employees are also required to comply with applicable Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards.

The OCWR Office of the General Counsel enforces the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHAct) as applied by the CAA. Individuals alleging a violation may file a request for inspection with the OCWR General Counsel. ## In-Person
